HEAVY LIFT WAREHOUSE WITH 400 TON CRANE CAPACITY

As the operator of the heavy cargo and bulk cargo terminal Krefeld, we are expanding our scope at the Rhine River. Starting in January 2015, we have extended our service portfolio with a 4,000 square metre storage and assembly hall serving as an addition to port operations and our open-air storage area. Two coupleable overhead travelling girder cranes in the hall are available for the lifting of components weighing up to 400 tons. With a height of some 19 metres and a connection to the modes of transport railway, road and water, the new hall offers even better options for the storage and assembly of heavy cargo.

Furthermore, with the extension of the existing open-air storage and handling areas to some 40,000 square metres, the terminal caters to the requirements of the transport industry in an even better way. Moreover, this, the region's only heavy cargo terminal on the left side of the Rhine River also possesses an ISPS approval and our employees have the corresponding qualification. Thus, the facility also meets the regulations for compliance with safety in the chain of delivery issued by the International Maritime Organization (IMO) and the European Union (EU).

- Heavy goods warehouse on the left bank of the Rhine, with 4000 m² of storage and assembly space
- Indoor crane with a maximum load capacity of 400 tons
- Oil collection tank for transformers and other oil-filled systems
- 40,000 m² of free storage and handling space
- 500 tons of handling capacity on the quay
- Quay wall reinforced for the use of mobile and crawler cranes
- 124 metre-long quay
- Multimodal interface for transferring goods between transport carriers travelling by rail, road and water
- Manufacture of industrial packaging by partner companies
- Loading, unloading and stowing coasters
